## **Various Others - September 14 – Oktober 21 2018**

In September 2018 Munich hosts the first edition of *Various Others*. It is the world's first cooperative project between galleries, off-spaces and museums. While joint openings and the event's focus are scheduled for the weekend 14<sup>th</sup>- 16<sup>th</sup> September the whole program spans over a period of five weeks.

Together the participants want to create an exchange between galleries, institutions and curatorial projects on an international level. Furthermore it is their aim to implement new strategies for collaboration between cultural institutions.

Participating galleries and project spaces invited international partner-galleries to develop an exhibition project together, while the participating museums will offer a comprehensive thematic program – also with international guests – ranging from discussions, artist talks to lectures and presentations. Among others, events with Pipilotti Rist, Hans Peter Feldmann, Jutta Koether, Kim Gordon, Stephanie Rosenthal and Tracey Emin will be part of the institutional program.
